I want to thank you for your good service and very good products. In 2012 I had a small accident with a Pro 57B. I bent the boom and totaled part of the 2nd director.

Your parts and engineering personnel went overboard to come up with a work around for my boom since my tubing size was no longer available. This Pro was an original with the 57B upgrade mod.

The PRO 57B had all it joints cleaned and reassembled with new no-ox and all trap caps replaced as well as a few broken driven element support insulators. The antenna is back up at 55ft and works as good as new! Over the fall to spring DX season I put it to the test and it passed with flying colors.

I had a CL-33 in storage (dry but not climate controlled) ever since I replaced it with the Pro 57 many years ago. I removed it from storage, cleaned it, reassembled it, and put it back up for a temporary antenna until the Pro was repaired. It worked like a champ as it did when new, but I did miss the 17 and 12 meter bands.

Thanks for, as your ad states, a couple of lifetime antennas. Mosley quality is still the standard for others to meet.
